Trachoma is an ancient yet contemporary scourge It is a specific kerato-conjunctivitis caused by certain serovars of Chlamydia trachomatis It affects an estimated 84 million people and remains the commonest communi-cable cause of blindness in 6 million people WHO has introduced the SAFE strategy which needs to be implemented with more
